WHAT IS CLIMALOC?

CliMaLoc stands for "Climate Mainstreaming Locally in the Baltic Sea Region", a project which aims to collect and exchange existing good practices on climate adaptation of small and medium municipalities from the Baltic Sea Region (BSR). The handbook "Localising climate in the BSR" is produced and disseminated to suppor localisation actions in the region.

WHO IS IN CLIMALOC?

Council of the Baltic Sea States (CBSS), a platform for intergovernmental cooperation among 10 countries in the BSR and the EU.

Associations of local governments from Estonia (AECM), Latvia (LALRG) and Lithuania (ALAL) gather cities and municipalities to share experience and promote action on climate adaptation.

Union of Baltic Cities (UBC) - Sustainable Cities Commission and Baltic Sea States Sub-regional Cooperation (BSSSC), in their capacity of pan-Baltic organisations bring in knowledge and dissemination capacity to regions and municipalities in 10 BSR countries.
