the NEEDS project's Policy Recommendations

After careful research, project implementation and analysis of project results (- taking input from students, teachers, researchers, experts, practitioners etc. into consideration) the following actions are strongly recommended for application in the respective CPN countries across the Baltic Sea Region:

1. Initiate more, regular international opportunities for Higher Education Institutions (HEI) & practitioners to get together.

Besides the existing BEP, the umbrella of the network's CBSS presidency could include:

- an annual Summer University (and potentially upcoming a Summer School) utilising the NEEDS course
- annual Erasmus+/ Exchange of Experts exchanges
- online seminars and workshops utilising the NEEDS outputs
- 2. Promote the NEEDS Online Course and Community and encourage staff to complete the course and join the community.
- 3. With the aim to initiate the establishment of security themed school curricula, conduct policy dialogues with Educational Ministries and other relevant stakeholders in respective countries.
 - This can be carried out using national resources or facilitated by external funding through initiatives and projects such as NEEDS.
- 4. Acknowledge the need for a common online platform for societal security education and collaboration and initiate an interagency discussion on a suitable platform.
 - Based on NEEDS project research, the project uses the CMiNE and TUOVI platforms for its own purposes and makes thereby use of existing structures which could be used further.
- Designate resources (people, funding, internship opportunities) and provide educational opportunities in the respective agencies to create a basis for common BSR education on societal security.
